Policy on the implementation of social reintegration program one of the Dictorate General of Correctional to overcome overcrowded prisons in many state detention houses, correctional institutions, and specialized development institutes of children throughout Indonesia. Research focuses on how the community advisory rolein the social reintegration program and dig out the extent of the factors that could impact the Social reintegration success. This research is research with both primary and secondary data collection using the qual tive research method. With this research came the fundamental idea of community advisory roleimplemented in the implementation of Social reintegration programs that the optimination of the part can be more maximally the achievement of Social reintegration. The social reintegration program's success will reduce the recidivism number of child clients in the future and encourage the development of an overcrowded program in Correctional Institution.

### 1. Introduction

The criminal system in Indonesia started with the justice Minister Mr Sahardjo in a confence of Prisoner in Lembang year 1963 when he ceived the award. The Institute of Education's establishment that ppas sources that combine in carrying out the law offenders' habilitation is necessary. 1963 Mr Sahardjo believes that the term prison should be improved by introducing the term Correctional institution.[1]According to Barda Nawawi Arief (2002), criminal detention has undergone a fundamental change as it is poud into the Correctional system, whein the Correctional system of Correctional business is based on the healing of prisoners behaviour, the construction of guiding prisoners and the pair of prisoners to be ady to be turned to the midst of society. [2]Correctional Institution (Lapas) Expected not just the place of people who a guilty to serve the period, but rather the penitentiary institution can be a place to build, to nurtu and to sto prisoners so that after undergoing the period of criminal prison can turn to the middle of the family and society and can live independent who a equipped during the construction institution. Weunderstand what is outlined in *Standard Minimum Rules* (SMR), in which an excellent residential room should be able to provide the mobility space for every prisoner either to sleep or other activities in the place of the reresidence. [4]Overcrowded that occurs today is not accompanied by the improvement of facilities and supporting facilities built for prisoners and prisoners that exist. It should then be Correctional to overcome the above-crowded conditions in many Correctional institutions and the state detention house in most Indonesia.[5]Following the state of Lapas and Rutan residential content, more than half of Correctional Institution (Lapas) and State Detention House (Rutan) have an excess single from its capacity.[6]




Table 1. Comparison Of Lapas/Rutan Content And Lapas/Rutan, The Drain Capacity




Table 2. BAPAS Community Advisory Client Data

[9]The crowded situation in which he was A Correctional work unit to be an issue in the construction of prisoners. An incasingly redense prisoners condition can be at risk of conflict in prison; this condition is ultimately the policy in the Lapas is mo concentrated on the realization of safe prison conditions or in other words, the concentricities on the security approach is more prominent so that the development activities and social rehabilitation in the Prisons a not maximums.[10]The statment of this condition can be taken by the acceleration of the social reintegrationprogram, and to support the socialreintegration activities of the community development role becomes very vital. The purpose of mentoring tutoring in participating in the acceleration program of the implementation of social reintegrationis undoubtedly expected to be very helpful in reducing the density of residential in the Lapas/Rutan.[11]

Overcrowded, which took place in Lapas/Rutan in Indonesia, can potentially harm the war criminal and the child because the fundamental right received is not maximized because of the condition. [12]Correctional system organizers should be able to find the right formula to overcome the situation crowded, where if this condition is not dealt with sevely in the future can cause problems in the institution can even cate a loss of good for individuals such as not fulfilled the fundamental rights of every holder of an/inmate and child, including his family. [13]A Correctional institution as a party that organizes the penitentiary system in Indonesia should work more maximally to overcome overcowding so that this condition can be appropriately solved so that the institution's development program and social habilitation can be done well. [14] The condition must accelerate Social reintegration implementation, which includes social reintegrationfor child and prisoners. This acceleration program is an implementation of the Circular Director general of Correctional number: PAS-1386. PK. 01.04.06 years 2019 on the implementation of social reintegration program. [15]

Progssive Dictorate General of Correctional with the acceleration of the Social reintegration program to overcome overcrowdingis very urgent to be reallized immediately by the ranks of Correctional.[16]The social rereintegration program's application is carried out by simplifying administrative quiments on the awarding of Social reintegration program for children and general criminal prisoners.[17]The measure undertaken include: community search made by community advisory arranged to seek the contents of the document, the community advisory has the guarantor's responsibility, and optimizes the role of a community advisory in allizing the social reintegration program. Tested this search shows how a community advisory rolein implementing a social reintegration program and understanding what factors impact a community advisory rolein a social rereintegrationprogram.[18]

In this case, the success of the 3 untry, the Correctional Directorate, becomes very important to reduce the condition of *overcrowded*. Hopefully, the role of a community advisory in the implementation of the social reintegration programcan improve the performance of coaching and rehabilitation programs in the prison so that it can reeventually realize the correctional purpose as mandated in Law number 12 the year 1995 about the penitentiary system. ### Interview

Moehar Daniel (2003), in Social search method, explains that:An interview is a series of data-related activities conducted by a searcher by attending a Live Meeting of Face-to-face activities between searchers and informants, and researchers have ppad the study instrument in the form of interview guides. [34]An Interview guide compiled by searchers as a guiding tool in asking the informant is known as the *interview guide*. Interviews collect information from the informant using the interview guidelines marked with the searcher's effort to gather data in a very detailed, namely against the various phenomena that have to do with the primary information to be collected.[35] In-depth interviews with key informants for this study can explain how the community advisory role to implement the *Social reintegration program* to obtain primary datafrom documentation studies. [2,35]

- The purpose of community advisoryas a Facilitator in the performance of Social reintegrationprogram in the functional:
- 4. Community advisory sole as client companion in the implementation of Social reintegration program;
- 5. Factors of retardant the role of a community advisoryin the performance of social reintegration program.[36]

A community advisory is a series of activities that a a task that a community advisory must carry to conduct training activities, guidance, supervision, and conducting community search. All these activities we integrated into the job and function as a community supervisor in the social reintegration program implementing the child criminal justice system. [37]

The task of the community advisoryis the implementation of the enforcement of regulation of the Minister of State apparatus and the form of the beucracy of the public of Indonesia number: 22 years 2016 about the available position of a social reintegration officer, the technical officers of the general counselling a prisoners who a given duties, responsibilities, and authorities to carry out activities in the field of a community advisory.[38]

The duties, responsibilities, and authority of the community advisorya:

- 1. Community search is a series of activities ranging from the data of the client and other data sources, whether the family even victims so that it can produce community search will give about various aspects of clients, families, violations of the law as well as the views of multiple parties, including victims or families of victims to client problems;[39]
- 2. Guidance is an effort by a community advisory in assisting clients in addssing legal issues that the client is facing so that the client can overcome that problem and achieve a change of life in a better diction;[40]
- 3. Guidance is a series of relief and guidance activities to improve the quality of steadiness of the Almighty God, intellectuals, attitudes and behaviours, professionalism, physical and spiritual health of Correctional clients and events that support the efforts of clients can live independently;[41]
- Supervision is a series of observation and assessment activities on the implementation of service programs, coaching and guidance of prison reresidents based on the commendation of community search

- port/Determination/Decision of judges and supervision during the client undergo a guidance program in the Correctional Hall;[42]
- 5. The session of TPP (Team of public observers) a series of activities undertaken by the penitentiary team to provide advice and commendations on the results of Community search and assessment conducted by a social reintegration officer, thus producing a proposal that is most appropriate for the client.[43]

Social reintegrationprogram is from the correctional system where by prisoners have the right to be granted social reintegration program throughout the prisoners, and children have qualified administration and substantive. [44]Directorate General of Correctional Ministry of Law and Human Rights RI makes a breakthrough in countermeasures overcrowded by accelerating social integragrion programs' implementation to control the number of Detention House of state and Correctional institution inhabitants, which continues to show significant incases in numbers over time.[45] According to Dr Sri Puguh Budi Utami, as Director-General of the Association, the mandate in vitalizing Correctional implementation could be realized if all disciplinary components can occur as they should the penitentiary purpose can be appropriately implemented.

Social reinitaration program by seeking acceleration of Social reintegration program provision for children and prisoners as the circular letter of the Director general of Correctional Number: PAS-1386. PK. 01.04.06, the year 2019

### The role of a community advisory in the social reintegration program, among others:

 a. Simplification of the contents of community search documents (Community search) of social reintegration program.

One of the important tasks undertaken by the Correctional Hall is to implement community search. Community search is a collection of valuable materials from lawbaker yang compiled by a community advisory, psented in the form of a port that clearly describes the circumstances and background of a person at psent, thein coved by analysis and conclusion of the situation and the determination of the steps that will be taken to plan the next guidance program.

### b. Role of Community advisory as guarantor

In the Community advisory module, the assurance can be a person; this person's guarantee is ferd to as guaranter (article 36 PP No. 27 the year 1983 on the implementation of KUHAP). A guarantor is a party that will be sponsible for guaranteeing the prisoners to be filed for social reintegration program, and a guarantor is a person who has a lationship with the client either from an individual or an institution/organization. In the process of filing social reintegrationfor children and prisoners and has been able to have substantive terms and administrative quiments, prisoners should get the family's guarantee.[46]

In the circular *social reintegration program*, the community advisory supervisor is appointed as a guarantor prisoner who has no guarantor. In its implementation at the Correctional Hall Palembang, the role of community guiding as a guarantor, among others:

- The community advisory is obliged to make a statement by completing the prisoner's guarantee letter. The letter
  of guarantee stated that it could guarantee the convicts/children in implementing their social reintegration
  program will not commit any unlawful deeds, and community advisory will assist in guiding and supervising the
  prisoners/children concerned.[47]
- The community advisory supervises the prisoners/children under its supervision. Supervision performed by the community guidelines as follows:
  - a) Observe the observation and assessment of the implementation of social reintegration program, coaching, and guidance of Correctional residents based on the commendation of community search port/Determination/verdict of Judges.
  - b) They we supervising prisoners and children to be obedient, porting within the allotted period lating to the daily activities.
  - c) In implementing mentoring tutoring as a guarantor, the public instruction also has to perform the guidance in Social reintegration time. Coaching the client's Correctional client will undergo supervision by visiting the coaching stages: an early stage, an advanced stage, and the final step.
  - d) Mentoring tutoring made a homevisit to know and know the situation/condition of the environment whe the prisoners/children a concerned.
  - e) They we conducting proposals to voke the social reintegration program when the convicts proved to have peated criminal acts.[48]

### a. The role of the community advisory as a facilitator

Mentoring tutoring in acting as a facilitator in the implementation of social reintegration program by giving support, providing support to clients to appeare the value that clients have, stugthening the client, and acknowledging the client to cognize their contributions work. [49]The support provided by a community supervisor can be formal and informal. The community advisory should build consensus with fellow parties to

cooperate in the client's potential development framework. Community advisoryshould also be able to play a role in facilitating individual clients, group clients, and communities to incase the productivity of clients to live independently during society.[50]

Community advisoryexpected to demonstrate a role providing facilitative for clients to devote their capabilities revoke each client's potential, the client in the group, and the community in managing the existing and the business in which the will be efficiently and by the client. The community advisorymust be able to do mediation and negotiation, which is that generalguidance will act to become a mediator in utilizing sources available with other parties to expand cooperation activities by benefitting thesocial reintegration program for the better. [51]

### d. Community advisory role as client guidance

Community advisory role in supporting clients who social reintegration as a concern for clients when clients have problems in the implementation of Social reintegrationprograms that various parties can participate so that the clients typing in the community can be well received by appreciating the presence of the client as part of a community that has the right to be able to carry on the sociability of the public. [52] The community advisory involved in assisting clients to be accepted by the public through the mass media to know the work of the client individual, the group's clients, so that various components of the propositional society can take the client.[53]The facilitator, the client in implementingthe social reintegration program, is an educational process that the role of society becomes very significant in the success, so various stakeholders should broadly take part in the client's role in the community. [54]

The purpose of community advisoryconducting verbal and written presentations, data collection management and data analysis, the ability to use the computer, and the ability to perform financial control, and do *need assessment* of the development of potential clients individual group of clients and society can be a turning point in an integrated guidance process. [55]

### e. Factors that inhibit therole of a community advisory in Social reintegration

The role of the Community advisoryin the implementation of social reintegration the child clien correctional Hall has been executed well, and following procedures, but the application several factors impact the role of a community advisory in the implementation of *social reintegration*, among others:

- In the manufactu of community search for social reintegration program, the social reintegrationprogram's
  application of its data excavation is less profounder. They will complicate community advisoryknowing the
  background, life history, and challenging to see the chronology of criminal acts that the prisoners had done. It
  made the Correctional Hall challenging to consider in the provision of social reintegration, and in the end,
  Correctional Hall cannot reject the proposal without knowing the background of the prisoner/child in
  question;
- 2) Prisoner/children who do not perform or demonstrate good behaviour during the sentence and do not carry out obligations while in prison with Social reintegration policy, community advisorycannot ject the proposal of his social reintegrationprogram. Thus, prisoners easily bathe mentoring outdoors without following a coaching program in the Lapas/Rutan;
- 3) The Community advisorycould not guarantee morally and material the life of the prisoner, and in the supervision of the social reintegration officer, prisoners we challenging to supervise the prisoner within 24 hours x 7 days; [56]

### 4. Discussion

A Community advisory role in implementing *Social reintegration program* is to facilitate prisoners and children to obtain the right to social reintegration. *Social reintegration* is expected to control the number of residents in detention houses and Correctional institutions in Indonesia, whe the available occupancy of the housing can no longer provide enough space for children and prisoners.[57]

The search documents made by the general guidance as an attempt in the proposal of *social reintegration program* for children client, if community search document is simplified/summarized to only be two pages to ease and save the time of the extensive tutoring in the manufactu of community search, in the community search page contains the introduction, Identity, Analysis, conclusion and commendation and closing.

Judging from community search contents, which contains only two pages, it is less levant in studying the convict data. The Community search will complicate the community advisoryin knowing the background, the life history, and the problematic chronology of the prisoner's criminals that had been carried out. The appanter prisoner circumstances and experience complicate the Mentoring tutoring to plan the next guidance program.[58]

With this circular letter's lease, the community advisorygets a new workload that should be done, namely, being a guarantor is not easy. The role of community advisory as guarantors will not be optimal in guaranteeing the convicts. These due to several things: the adviser can ensu the convict's life (especially in financial/financial); the

community advisory can supervise prisoners within 24 hours; community advisory can apply only to the prisoners to obey the need to port to the Conscional Hall. [59]

The study discusses the role of a community advisoryin the implementation of a social reintegration program. Correctional vitalization aims: improving the function of tutoring, as outlined in article 2 point C on the gulation of the Minister of Law and HAM RI number: 35 the year 2018 on community advisoryhave to simplify administrative on the proposal of Social reintegrationprogramand appointed as the guarantor of prisoner guarantor Dictor-General of Correctionalnumber: PAS-1386. [60]Who do not have the loan 1386 PK.01.04.06 years 2019 about the implementation of the social reintegrationprogramfor childrenclient and prisoners, the midsize involved community advisoryto facilitate the proposal of Social reintegrationprogramfor children and prisoners concerning the role theory, the guided community is requid to implement these roles. The analysis of data searchers to the search showed that the purpose of a community advisoryin the implementation of social reintegrationprogramrelated to role theory that performed by the community guidelines. [61] Community Guidance should demonstrate his role when a person carries out his rights and obligations following his position, and he performs from the dynamic aspect of the location. The Community advisorycan be measured from duties and functions in conducting supervision, guidance, coaching, and Community search to implement Social reintegrationprogramfollowing its position as law enforcement officers and Correctional officers. [43] Based on that understanding, to know.

It can be said that the community advisoryof Palembang Correctional Hall has implemented its rights and obligations as a role in the implementation of the *social reintegrationprogram during covid19 pandemic*. The community guide carried out its task to simplify the Social reintegration program's community search and be a guarantor, prisoners. Community Advisory also have the right to sanction the prisoner if they undergo a social reintegrationprogram for the child and the prisoner during the community or peat a criminal offence. [62]

Role theory is a view of sociological and psychological described as a form of behaviour that is not otherwise displayed in the value of the norm he has to behave in community life. The role is an attack of a person's activity to run his operations a day; for example, a teacher will act in class to teach students in a class. Thus, as in the role theory, the community's expectations guiding role as guarantors can improve the behaviour of convicts in everyday life.

Community advisory role of acting as a facilitator in the implementation of the social reintegration program, by giving *support*, whe the provision of support to the client to appciate, acknowledge and stngthen. The value owned by the client so that the community can show appciation to the client for the work done by the client. The support provided by a community supervisor can be formal and informal help. The community advisoryshould build consensus with various parties to cooperate with stakeholders to develop potential in the client. The community advisoryis expected to facilitate clients to incase client productivity to live independently during society.

Mentoring is expected to provide a facilitative for clients to devote their capabilities and the client in the group and the community to manage the existing and the business in which the will be efficiently and by the client.[63]Community advisory must develop, hold the mediation and negotiation; thus, a community supervisor serves as a mediator in the framework of the Utilization of sources available with the stakeholder to build cooperation so that the social reintegration program can run well.

The community 3 visory is a role in supporting clients who run social reintegration as a concern for clients when clients have problems in the implementation of social reintegration so that various parties can participate so that the clients typing in the community can be well ceived by appreciating the presence of the client as part of a community that has the right to be able to carry on the sociability of the public. The community advisory involved in assisting clients to be accepted by the public through the mass media to know the client's work, the group's clients, so that various components of the propositional society can take the client. Supervisor, the client in the implementation of social rereintegration, is an educational process that the role of society becomes very significant in the success of social reintegration program's performance, so various stakeholders should be able to take part in the role of the client in the community broadly. [65]

Community advisory also related data collection, analysts data, and must have the ability to convey psentations verbally or in writing, do *need assessment* to the development of potential client individual and hold management and conduct financial control, and, the group of clients and society can be a turning point in an integrated guidance process.[66]

The Community advisory rolein implementing the *Social reintegration program* at ts Correctional Hall has been executed well and following procedures. ### 5. Conclusion

This tactical step is done only to reduce the capacity and security stability from the state of overcrowding in the Lapas/Rutan in Indonesia. Social reintegration implementation with the move of social reintegration program to prisoners is not always able to run well, but the a obstacles in the application.

The community advisory role in implementing the *social reintegration program* is the right for children and prisoners if it has fulfilled the administrative requiments and the substantive conditions that have the purpose of the child and prisoner can turn to the midst of the community by obtaining *social reintegration program*. The *social reintegration* policy is expected to reduce the overcrowded condition in the Lapas/Rutan in almost all work units in Indone and this condition requise continuous effort to be in the residensity of residential in the institution. In carrying out the role of a community advisory in the implementation of social reintegration of child clients during the Covid19 Pandemic, certainly still the is slack in the field. Still, it can be solved to implement the Social reintegration program's acceleration program as expected.

The proportional Correctional Hall could meet the social reintegration program's targets to suggest providing proposals so that the children and prisoners proposed can be given a *social reintegration prog* meacording to the conventional procedus. The enhancement of the community advisory rolein acting as a facilitator in the implementation of Social reintegration is expected so that clients can get a chance to learn and attend an excellent guidance program when turning to the community. Establishing cooperation with various parties is undoubtedly a valuable space for the success of the social reintegration program. Similarly, the role of community advisory is a precious contribution to the social reintegration program's success that will eventually realize the realization of the Correctional vitalize program in Indonesia.
