ABSTRACT

The system aims to improve business processes, financial management, and corporate governance. Implementation enhances financial efficiency, accuracy, and strategic decision-making. Training and effective management support are vital for understanding the system and interpreting reports. A well-implemented accounting information system improves financial performance. The SIM-OP application scored 912 out of 24 features in the User Acceptance Test-Black Box evaluation. Functional testing of the SI-MOP application resulted in a highly functional rating of 5 (A grade).
