IMPLEMENTATION OF REGIONAL GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (SIPD) AT THE REGIONAL FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AGENCY (BPKD) OF LUMAJANG REGENCY

ABSTRACT

This research aims to determine the implementation of the Regional Government Information System (SIPD) and the obstacles or challenges that occur in the implementation of the Regional Government Information System (SIPD) at the Regional Financial Management Agency (BPKD) of Lumajang Regency. The method used is descriptive qualitative with data collection techniques using interviews. The results of this study indicate that the implementation of SIPD at the BPKD of Lumajang Regency has not been fully implemented because the accounting and reporting section has not used SIPD, the administration section is still in the transition stage and uses a local application (e-finance) in parallel, while the budgeting section has used SIPD fully. In addition, the BPKD of Lumajang Regency faces technical obstacles such as slow response from the Ministry of Home Affairs in providing solutions to technical problems. In this case, the implementation of SIPD at the BPKD of Lumajang Regency has not achieved the objectives in accordance with the Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 70 of 2019 concerning Regional Government Information Systems.
