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ABSTRACT

The background of this study is based on the development of MICE, expecially the implementation of hybrid events in Indonesia which is increasing rapidly. This is because hybris events are a new solution or breakthrough in organizing a practical and efficient event by combining offline events with virtual or online components. This study aims to analyze hybrid event management in Matamu Studio at Phenom Event Indonesia technically. This study uses a descriptive qualitative method with data collection using observation, interviews, and documentation. The sample of this study are three Matamu Studio division staff, one of whom is the head office or head of the divisio, while the others are two staff members. This study discusses human resources management in organizing hybrid events, hybrid event multimedia equipment management, and hybrid event implementation strategis in Matamu Studio.
