Effect of Combination of Apple Juice and Dragon Fruit on LDL Levels of Hypercholesterolemia Wistar Rats

ABSTRACT

The combination of apple and dragon fruit juice contains flavonoids that have the potential to help reduce LDL cholesterol levels. This study aimed to determine the effect of administering a combination of apple and dragon fruit juice on LDL cholesterol levels in Wistar rats with hypercholesterolemia. This research employed a True Experimental design with a Pretest-Posttest with Control Group Design. A total of 20 Wistar rats were used and divided into three groups: the negative control group (K-), the positive control group (K+), and the treatment group (P). Hypercholesterolemia was induced by administering a mixture of beef fat, used cooking oil, quail egg yolk at 5 ml per 200 grams of body weight, and PTU 0.01% as much as 100 ml for 30 days. The treatment group received an intervention consisting of a combination of apple and dragon fruit juice at a dose of 1.05 ml per rat. The LDL cholesterol levels were measured using the CHOD-PAP method. The data were analyzed using Shapiro-Wilk, One Way ANOVA, Post Hoc, and Paired T-Test. The results showed a significant difference in LDL levels at the pretest (p = 0.002) and posttest (p = 0.000). In the positive control group (K+), there was no significant difference between LDL levels in the pretest and posttest (p = 0.161), while in the treatment group (P), a significant difference was observed between LDL levels before and after the intervention (p = 0.001). However, the difference in LDL level changes between the groups before and after the intervention was not statistically significant (p = 0.303). Based on these findings, it can be concluded that the administration of the combination of apple and dragon fruit juice did not have a significant effect on reducing LDL cholesterol levels in hypercholesterolemic Wistar rats.
