

**Asta Cita Perspective: Village Fund Management for Food Security
(Case Study of Tempeh Tengah Village, Lumajang Regency)**

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study is to analyze the management of Village Funds for food security in Tempeh Tengah Village, Lumajang Regency, from the perspective of Asta Cita. The study uses a qualitative approach with a case study method through interviews, documentation, and literature review. The results of the study indicate that the management of Village Funds has been carried out in accordance with Permendagri Number 20 of 2018, including planning through village deliberations with a 20% allocation of Village Funds in the APBDes and RAB, the implementation of a duck farming program by BUMDes, orderly and transparent administration through Siskeudes, as well as reporting and accountability. From the perspective of Asta Cita, the management of Village Funds in Tempeh Tengah Village is in line with the principles of food self-sufficiency and village-based development, and contributes to increasing food availability, creating jobs, empowering the community, and strengthening the role of BUMDes.
