ABSTRACT

This study aims to analyze the use of Village Funds in supporting the achievement of Village Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in Curahmalang Village, Rambipuji District, Jember Regency. This study uses a qualitative descriptive method with data collection techniques using interviews and documentation. The results of the study indicate that the use of Village Funds has been directed to support the goals of Village SDGs and realize 9 Village SDGs goals, namely Villages Without Poverty, Villages Without Hunger, Healthy and Prosperous Villages, Quality Village Education, Equitable Village Economic Growth, Village Infrastructure and Innovation, Safe and Comfortable Village Settlement Areas, Villages Responsive to Climate Change, and Dynamic Village Institutions and Adaptive Culture. Although generally aligned with the principles of sustainable development, the Village SDGs program has not been fully distributed and is still dominated by the infrastructure and health sectors. Thus, in order for the Curahmalang Village Government to improve the equality of implementation of all Village SDGs, it is not only focused on the infrastructure and health sectors, but also gradually developing the economic empowerment and village innovation sectors so that the impact of development is more balanced.
