

***ANALYSIS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM OF
THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA (SIPD RI) USING THE CSE-UCLA
MODEL
(Case Study at the Srono Subdistrict Office in Banyuwangi Regency)***

ABSTRACT

This study aims to analyze the implementation of the Regional Government Information System of the Republic of Indonesia (SIPD RI) at the Srono District Office, Banyuwangi Regency, using the CSE-UCLA model. The background of this research is based on the importance of utilizing information technology to support the realization of good governance, as well as the existence of various obstacles in the implementation of SIPD RI. The study employs a qualitative method with a descriptive approach. Data collection techniques were carried out through observation, interviews, and documentation involving informants consisting of the Head of District, Secretary, Head of Planning and Finance Subdivision, and Expenditure Treasurer. The data analysis technique uses the CSEE-UCLA model which includes three components, namely program implementation, program improvement, and program certification. The results of the study indicate that in the program implementation component, socialization activities have been conducted, although not yet fully optimal. In the program improvement component, several technical obstacles are still encountered. Meanwhile, in the program certification component, the implementation of SIPD RI is considered sufficiently effective in supporting regional financial management, although improvements are still needed to enhance overall system performance.
