To find out the types of diseases that often occur, an application that can identify the disease is needed, the program or application uses Digital Image Processing and Artificial Neural Networks using the Gray Level Co-Occurrence Matrix and Learning Vector Quantization methods. The accuracy of using this method is 64.4444%.
